QUEEN OF HEAVEN & EARTH

Jeremiah 13:18 → *“Say to the king and to the queen mother: come down from your throne; From your heads fall your magnificent crowns.”*

1 Kings 2:18-20 → *“Very well,” replied Bathsheba, “I will speak to the king for you.” Then Bathsheba went to King Solomon to speak to him for Adonijah, and the king stood up to meet her and paid her homage. Then he sat down upon his throne, and a throne was provided for the king's mother, who sat at his right. “There is one small favor I would ask of you,” she said. “Do not refuse me.” “Ask it, my mother,” the king said to her, “for I will not refuse you.”*

QUEEN OF HEAVEN & EARTH

Revelations 11:19-12:1 → *“Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant could be seen in the temple. There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, and peals of thunder, an earthquake, and a violent hailstorm. A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.”*

Hail Holy Queen! → As our Mother, she guides us, prays for us, role models for us the path to Heaven, so that we too can become Saints!



QUEENSHIP OF MARY

- **Ad caeli reginam** by Pope Pius XII (11OCT1954) established the Feast of the Queenship of Mary
- Mary should be called Queen, not only because of her Divine Motherhood of Jesus Christ, her only son, but also because God has willed her to have an exceptional role in the work of our eternal salvation.
- Pope Pius IX, *“With a heart that is truly a mother's,” does she approach the problem of our salvation, and is solicitous for the whole human race; made Queen of heaven and earth by the Lord, exalted above all choirs of angels and saints, and standing at the right hand of her only Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, she intercedes powerfully for us with a mother's prayers, obtains what she seeks, and cannot be refused.”*

QUEEN OF HEAVEN & EARTH

Teaches us about ...

- Intercessory Prayer

- Points to Christ the King
- Teaches about the *Davidic Kingdom* and that there is a Divine plan for Salvation!

HOLY DAY: All Saint's Day

- **November 1st**
- **PURPOSE:** instituted to honor all the saints, known and unknown, and to supply any deficiencies in the celebration of Saints' feasts during the year. (Urban IV)
- Mention of a common day of celebration in a sermon of **St. Ephrem the Syrian** (373), (*Marian Doctor*) and in the 74th homily by **St. John Chrysostom** (407).
- **MARIAN ORIGIN:** The origin of the festival of All Saints celebrated in the West dates to May 13, 609 or 610, when Pope Boniface IV consecrated the Pantheon at Rome to the Blessed Virgin and all the martyrs.

Pope Gregory III (731–741) moved the date to November 1st.
- **MARIAN CUSTOMS:** In Mexico, All Saints Day coincides with the celebration of "*Día de los Inocentes*" (Day of the Innocents)

MARIAN APPARITIONS

PRIVATE REVELATION

Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) #67

Throughout the ages, there have been so-called "private" revelations, some of which have been recognized by the authority of the Church.

They do not belong, however, to the deposit of faith.

It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history.

Guided by the Magisterium of the Church, the *sensus fidelium* knows how to discern and welcome in these revelations whatever constitutes an authentic call of Christ or his saints to the Church.

Christian faith cannot accept "revelations" that claim to surpass or correct the Revelation of which Christ is the fulfillment, as is the case in certain non-Christian religions and also in certain recent sects which base themselves on such "revelations".
